SUBJECT: New Extended Content Standards Training for English Language Arts (ELA)/Math

The NC Department of Public Instruction is pleased to offer two (2) face to face training opportunities for the New Extended Content Standards. This professional learning opportunity will be the first of a series of opportunities provided to meaningfully improve the performance and success of students with Significant Cognitive Disabilities (SCD) and to ensure academic alignment for both ELA (K-12) and Math (K-8). The goals of the training are:

- 1. To address the components of the NC Extended Content Standards as it related to ELA and Mathematics.
- 2. To increase the knowledge of the professionals on the newly adopted NC Extended Content Standards for ELA and Mathematics.
- 3. Facilitate access to professional development resources related to ELA and Mathematics.

The training for this course will also include online modules that will be developed in the near future. Participants will be expected to complete the full day and will receive .6 CEUs. No partial credit will be given.

In an effort to maximize this opportunity for all LEAs and Charter Schools, only two (2) teachers per district will be allowed on a first come, first serve basis.
