## WHAT CAN I DO AS A PARENT TO PROTECT MY TEEN?

**Tip #1** Be a role model for online behavior. Watch what you say and post on your social media. Teens see what adults do and learn from it.

**Tip #2** Teach your teens to keep their passwords private. If you sign in using a friend's phone make sure you sign out of your account. It takes one time to forget and then someone has access to your online world.

**Be aware of adults (and even other teens) that follow your teen on social media. Delete and block those that are not known in real life.**
