COMPLETING THE DIGITAL LEARNING PROGRESS RUBRIC

During its June meeting, the North Carolina State Board of Education reaffirmed a 2015 requirement that all districts and charter schools complete the Digital Learning Progress Rubric. In response, NCDPI extended the due date to **August 15, 2018**. It can be completed electronically and should be submitted using the following link: https://schools.nc.gov/dlrubric.

The interface to submit the rubric is the same as the Digital Learning and Media Inventory. System administrators (DLMI LEA Admin or DLMI Charter Admin) should already have a user account established. If you have any questions about access, please visit the <u>DLMI Wiki</u>.

NCDPI and The Friday Institute research team will have *internal* access to district and charter school records for planning Digital Learning initiatives. District-level data from the Digital Learning Progress Rubric will not be shared publicly, only aggregate trends may be reported. A Digital Learning rubric steering committee has been formed and will meet in the summer to create the ultimate data-sharing rules for the data. Participants from all eight SBE regions, charter schools, and North Carolina statewide partner organizations are members of this committee. Any changes to data-sharing decisions will be communicated via the superintendents' weekly update and technology directors list.
