## Clarification to K-3 Diagnostic Data Submission

The K-3 Formative and Diagnostic Assessment Data Sharing memo was sent to Public School Units including charter schools on October 9, 2020. It directed PSUs to submit BOY data to NCDPI from the K-3 diagnostic reading assessment. Because legislation does not require charter schools to use the assessments designated by the state to measure K-3 reading performance, charter schools are **not required** to submit data from the K-3 diagnostic assessments used.
