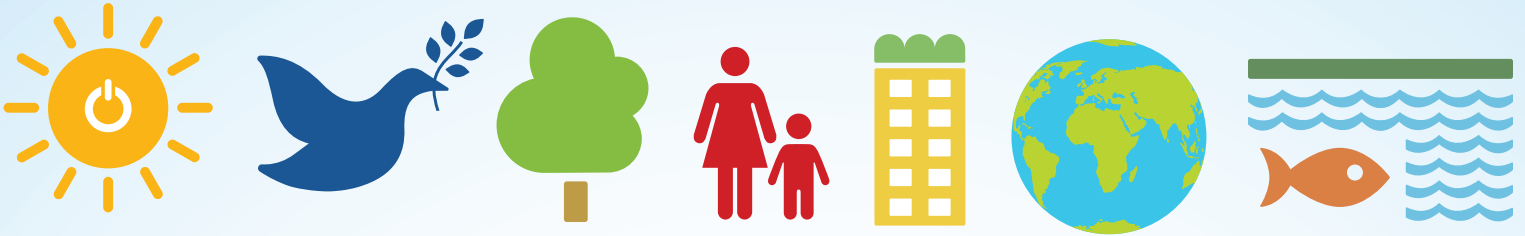


Climate Resiliency Art Contest
