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| | <ul style="list-style-type: none">● In most districts, adoption may mean that you may need to consider having the plan reviewed and approved by their Board of Education/Governing Body no later than July 1, 2021. Each PSU will need to review their internal process for “adoption.”● Each PSU will upload the plan by September 15th with Other Healthy Active Children Policy Items.<ul style="list-style-type: none">○ A link will be posted by the Healthy Schools Section and School Mental Health Initiative Live DPI WebPage○ Each PSU has a person that is designated to upload information into this system.
