

NCAPP AP Summer Institutes: AP Gov & Pol June-July 2021



The College Board North Carolina AP Partnership is pleased to provide scholarship opportunities for designated North Carolina school personnel to attend an Advanced Placement Summer Institute (APSI) in North Carolina. Scholarships are available to each of the 115 districts in North Carolina. Scholarships cover the cost of registration and lab fees.

If you were notified by your district that you were awarded a North Carolina AP Partnership scholarship to attend an AP Summer Institute, your next step is to select an APSI location, date, and subject you wish to attend from this brochure. Your district should have provided you with a scholarship award notification letter as confirmation of your scholarship award. A copy of the award letter may be required by the AP Institute at the time of registration to receive a scholarship registration code or scholarship registration instructions.

Once you have made your APSI choice, register with your selected AP Institute. Seats at AP Summer Institutes fill up quickly and having a scholarship does not guarantee you a seat at any AP Summer Institute. You should go to the selected APSI's and register with them. Please contact the AP Institute Director if you need assistance with your registration or have questions regarding APSI course offerings. **You must register at your APSI by May 30, 2021.** If you fail to register with the institute by the deadline date, your scholarship will be forfeited.

After registering for your APSI, notify your district APSI contact with your course information (AP Institute location, AP subject, and workshop date). Your district is required to provide your APSI information (your name, contact information, AP Summer Institute location, AP subject and workshop date) to the North Carolina Partnership office. This information is required to arrange payment of your APSI tuition. Your tuition fee will be paid by the North Carolina AP Partnership directly to the AP Institute at the conclusion of the workshop.
