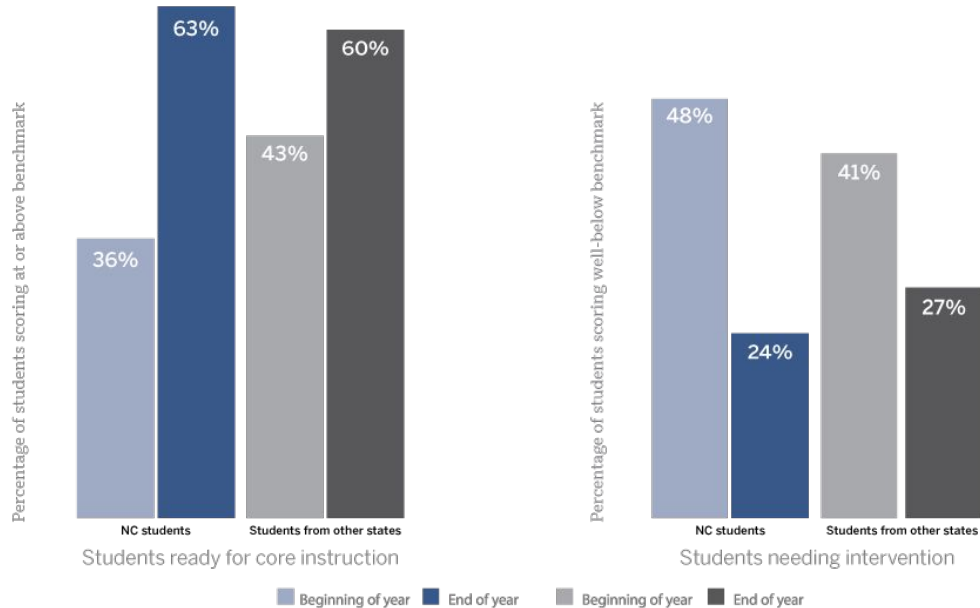


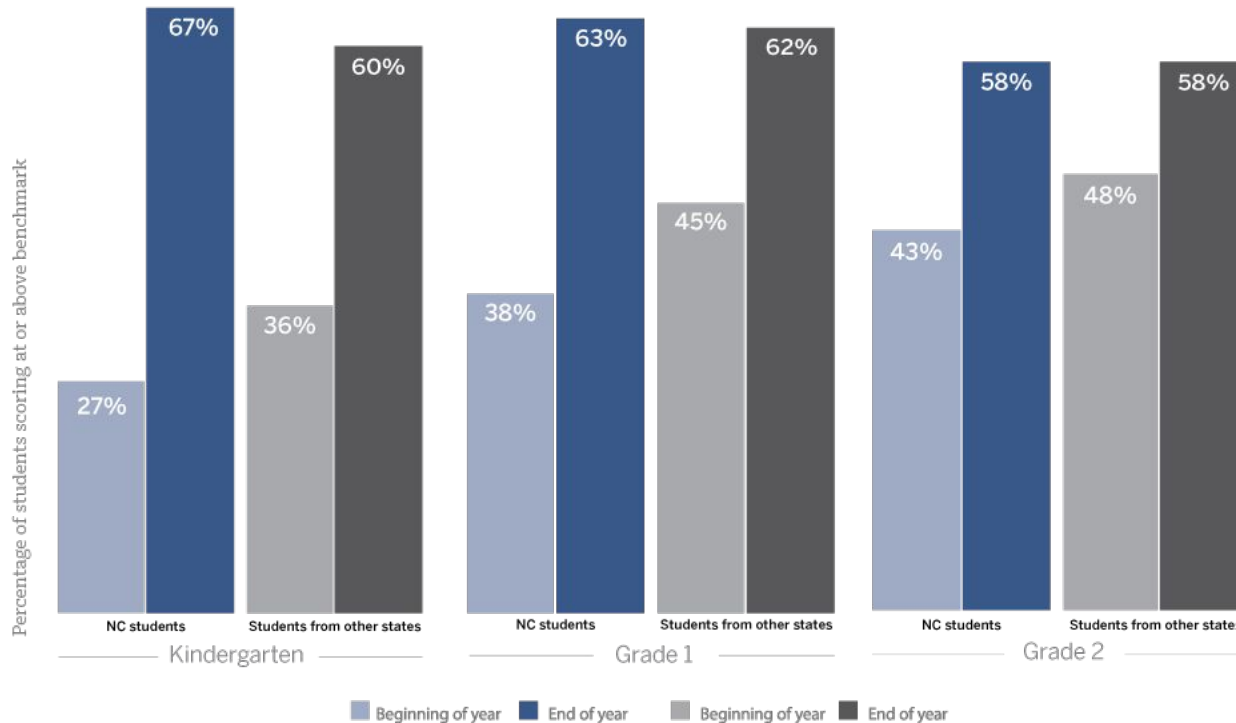
North Carolina K-2 students achieve greater literacy gains than students from other states
