**PreACT, PreACT 8/9, and PreACT Secure**

- Choose your test date (September 1 – June 1 each year) in addition to the NC DPI fall test window
- Special NC pricing = \$16 per answer document scored
- PreACT Secure – available Spring 2023 – grade 10, online, \$19, choose from one of 3 test windows
- PreACT 8/9 – developed for 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> graders – are your students on track?

**Special NC ACT Pricing**

- ACT extends state pricing to districts or schools wishing to test additional cohorts outside of the NC DPI-funded state testing program – *ideal for a senior retake option*
- Available for 10<sup>th</sup>, 11<sup>th</sup>, and 12<sup>th</sup> grades
- The cost is \$33.50 for the ACT (a savings of \$29.50 over national testing)
- Fall and Spring dates available
