Spotlight on: Exceptional Children's Assistance Center

Exceptional Children's Assistance Center (ECAC) is a free resource for parents, families, and professionals throughout the state. ECAC works with families of children and youth with disabilities from birth to 26 to help parents participate effectively in their child's education and development.

ECAC is North Carolina's Parent Training and Information (PTI) Center, a federally funded program through the U.S. Department of Education, Office of Special Education Programs (OSEP). They provide trainings about all things related to the special education process for parents and professionals, provide support to young adults with disabilities to become self-advocates and leaders, and partner with professionals and policymakers to improve outcomes for all children with disabilities.

ECAC's team of parent educators help parents communicate and work with their school teams. All parent educators are parents to a child with a disability and know what it's like to go through this process on a technical and personal level.
