

North Carolina K-12 Math Standards Timeline

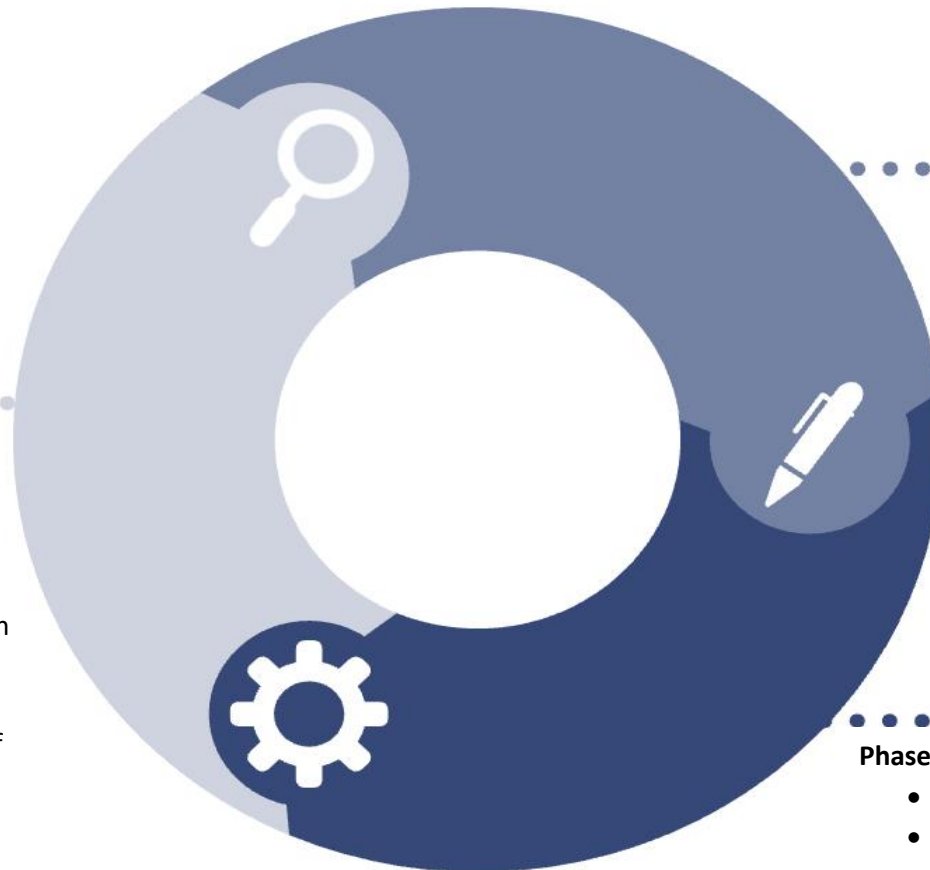
In April 2023 the State Board of Education approved a Procedures Manual to govern the process by which NCDPI will conduct the review and revision of the content area standards. There are three phases: the review, revision, and implementation.

Each phase is feedback-based, research-informed, improvement-oriented, and process-driven. Throughout each step NCDPI will provide regular and frequent communication such as: details of each step, updates on work completed, requests for input, as well as seeking educator and stakeholder participation.

Review

Phase 1 (May 2024 – April 2025)

- Gather research from other states, and organizations.
- Conduct interviews and focus groups across the state.
- Seek input on math standards through surveys with all stakeholders.
- Establish a math Data Review Committee to complete an analysis of student outcomes in math, results from surveys and interviews/focus groups.



Revision

Phase 2 (April 2025 – June 2026)

- Establish writing team to edit/revise standards based on analysis provided by the Data Review Committee.
- Submit multiple drafts for review by stakeholders.
- Submit for SBE approval.

Implementation

Phase 3: 5-7 Years

- 2026-2027: Installation
- 2027-2028: Initial Implementation
- 2028-2031: Full Implementation
