Helene Survey and Legislative Update

The <u>Hurricane Helene Days Missed Survey</u> has opened and will close on **Monday**, **December 16**, **2024**, at 11:59 p.m. This mandatory reporting, per <u>Session Law 2024-51 Section 1.8.(d)</u> and <u>Session Law 2024-53</u>, requires all public school units (PSUs) impacted by Hurricane Helene and PTC8 to submit reports to the Department of Public Instruction on the days missed due to the storms, as well as the scheduled make up days and days deemed completed. <u>Senate Bill 382</u> has been passed by the General Assembly and is awaiting the governor's signature. Should it become law, Section1B.1. will allow PSUs to deem days missed in November due to Hurricane Helene as completed.
