Applying for a North Carolina Driver License

To obtain a North Carolina Driver's License or permit, applicant must apply at a NC Division of Motor Vehicles Driver License Office.

Please note the following:

1. A parent, legal guardian, or other approved person who has legal guardian papers must be present to sign the application for license or permit.
2. Fees sufficient to cover the cost of license or permit must be paid.
3. The driver education certificate, a driver eligibility certificate, a social security card and proof of residence must be shown.
4. DMV requires proof of your age and identity to protect the public from driver license fraud. A certified or original copy of the applicant's birth certificate is needed to determine the applicant's age.

Note: In lieu of a birth certificate, and unexpired, stamped photo passport will be accepted.

5. When applying for a driver's license, a completed certificate of liability insurance coverage, Form DL – 123, from an insurance company is required.

Note: A completed certificate of liability coverage is not needed to apply for a learner's permit.
