Applying for a North Carolina Driver License

To obtain a North Carolina Driver's License or permit, applicant must apply at a NC Division of Motor Vehicles Driver License Office. Please note the following:

- 1. A parent, legal guardian, or other approved person who has legal guardian papers must be present to sign the application for license or permit.
- 2. Fees sufficient to cover the cost of license or permit must be paid.
- 3. The driver education certificate, a driver eligibility certificate, a social security card and proof of residence must be shown.
- 4. DMV requires proof of your age and identity to protect the public from driver license fraud. A certified or original copy of the applicant's birth certificate is needed to determine the applicant's age.

 Note: In lieu of a birth certificate, and unexpired, stamped photo passport will be accepted.
- When applying for a driver's license, a completed certificate of liability insurance coverage, Form DL 123, from an insurance company is required.
 Note: A completed certificate of liability coverage is not needed to apply for a learner's permit.
