## FY 2026 CCIP Consolidated Application Timeline

 June 2, 2025: Consolidated Application Opens (pending allotment being synced into CCIP)

NOTE: The application cannot be moved out of Draft Started status until the Remaining Funds have synced with CCIP. (Estimated to occur by second week of July)


 August 31, 2025: Submissions Due (Applications are considered submitted, when they are moved to Chief Administrator Approved Status.)



June 2 is the expected opening date, but the planning allotments have to be synced into the system before you will be able to access the Consolidated Shell.

Only after the Remaining Funds amounts are finalized in the state's budgeting system in early July, will you be allowed to move your application out of Draft Started status.

Applications are due on August 31.



Make sure you select 2026 and Consolidated.

#### **Title I Grant Details**



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In the grant details page, most of the changes are in the phrasing. We will refer to the Set-asides page when discussing these changes, but we will go into specifics about the set-asides page afterwards.

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We will start with #4. Not much has changed here except for some of the phrasing. Boxes A thru D are still typed-entry boxes for you to fill in. They are highlighted yellow here to point that out. They are not highlighted in CCIP. Box E will autofill based on what you type into the Setasides page. We'll go into detail about that in subsequent slides.



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
The phrasing at the top has been changed to emphasize that we are talking about ALL remaining funds you may have in BOTH your FY 25 and FY 24 budgets - plural.



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Box A is the same as before. Prior to July 1, you may be able to determine what your remaining amounts will be, and you can enter that. But in early July, if you learn the official amount is different, you will have to update Box A, and that will affect the other boxes here and some of your set-aside entries, as you will see in a few moments.



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There is no change for Box B, but we always see a need to address a misconception. The only time you have any dollars to type here is if you spent less than last year's <u>requirement</u>. This is not about spending less than whatever you budgeted for PFE, which many times is more than the required. Most LEAs will type a zero in this box, because they always spend at least 1% on PFE form year to year. If you are not required to use remaining funds for PFE but chose to do so, those dollars will be reported in Line 12A of the Set-asides page, not here.

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As before, in Box C, you will type the amount of your Remaining Funds that you want to make available for the School Allocations. Single site charter schools will leave this blank, because they have no other schools to allocate funds to.

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
Due to limitations inherent to CCIP, the amount you type in box D for equitable services will NO LONGER autofill on the Set-asides page in Line 2A. So, this year, unfortunately, you will have to enter this amount twice. More about this in a few moments.

Box E can be confusing, because nothing is actually typed in here. Instead, it autofills from the Set-aside entries that DON'T fit the descriptions above for B, C and D. More about that in a few moments.





So, let's sort through them, one at a time, starting with the total in Box A. Notice the set-asides page is represented on the right, and we'll zoom in on that.




This year, whatever you type in Grant Detail 4A will autofill in the "Carryover" column of Line 1 of the set-asides page. Except that we are now labeling it as Column A and referring to "Remaining Funds," not carryover.



As before, your Box B entry will autofill in Line 4A of the Set-asides page. Whatever you type here establishes the minimum amount of remaining funds you will devote to PFE, to go along with the 1% minimum in the current year budget. That's why we pointed out earlier that if you CHOOSE to use remaining funds for PFE (i.e., not required due to underspending), you would put those dollars in Line 12A of the Set-asides page, not here.






As always, Box C still autofills in Line 16 of the School Allocations page. This makes these dollars available for the calculation of minimum PPA (in Line 20, not shown here). And the amount in Line 16 gets added to Line 15 to give a total in Line 17, which is the amount that CCIP expects you will distribute to Title I schools in Column E of the School Allocations page. More on that in a few moments.




As mentioned a moment ago, Box D no longer autofills in Line 2 of the Set-asides page. Therefore, you will have to type the identical information twice as highlighted in pink here.



Box 4E works in the opposite direction, by summing up the values you type in Lines 5A through 14A of the Set-asides page.



Taken together, these arrows demonstrate that all the ways you can use Remaining Funds are accounted for in both Grant Detail #4 and in the Set-asides page – just in different arrangements. And some of the values can only be entered in Grant Detail #4, while others can only be entered in the Set-asides page.





When you go into CCIP, you will notice the phrasing of some of the descriptions is more precise regarding remaining vs current year funds, which you will be able to see when you log in.





The columns in the School Allocations page are the same as last year, and we will refer to them by their letter designation, E through K. We point that out here, because there are certain rules that govern the relationships of the Set-aside entries to these columns. And we will describe these rules one at a time.

But first, it's worth pointing out that the district will place the full intended amounts for each set-aside in the set-aside lines, regardless of how much of each one may be site-coded at the schools. The school allocations columns are only used to let DPI know how much of the set-asides will be site-coded at the schools in addition to the planned school allocations in Column G. Making this distinction allows us to verify that each school is appropriately budgeted.

For example, if a district set aside \$500,000 for pre-k with \$400,000 of that being reported in Column K, the Line 9 total would still be \$500,000 not \$100,000.



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For PRC 051, all the Grant details questions are still check-box statements. But they have been reworded to be more concise. You will see this when you log on.


