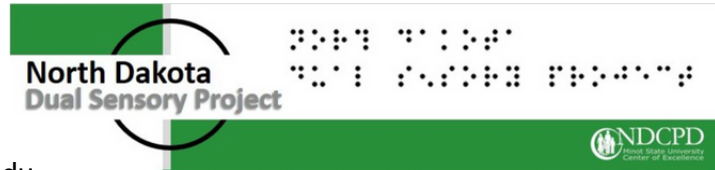




ONLINE TRAINING ON DEAFBLINDNESS

The North Dakota Dual Sensory Project is pleased to announce the FALL 2024 offerings of courses from the “Open Hands, Open Access” (OHOA) modules.

These online training modules were developed by the National Center on Deafblindness (NCDB) and are designed to provide training about various aspects of deafblindness education and support. These fully online courses provide practical strategies for educating children and youth with deafblindness and other disabilities.

COST: All participants will be charged a \$50 registration fee for each course. This will allow transcript recording of the credit upon successful completion. In addition, the project will reimburse each participant for their registration fee(s) upon successful completion, with support from the ND Department of Public Instruction, Office of Specially Designed Services.

WHO: Teachers, related services providers, early interventionists, and other educational staff are invited to participate in the online courses which are developed from the list of 27 OHOA modules.

The courses will be taught by ND Dual Sensory Project staff.

Each course is 1 graduate credit.

The course term for all course offerings is September 23 - December 13, 2024.
