

NEW SUSTAINABLE SOURCE OF REIMBURSEMENT FOR SCHOOL DISTRICTS THROUGH THE NORTH DAKOTA MEDICAID ADMINISTRATIVE CLAIMING (MAC) PROGRAM

The North Dakota Department of Health and Human Services (NDDHHS) is working with Public Consulting Group (PCG) to implement a new program that will allow North Dakota school districts to receive additional Medicaid reimbursement for activities that your staff are **ALREADY** performing on a regular basis.

This program can create a <u>SUSTAINABLE</u> source of reimbursement to replace lost funding such as Elementary and Secondary School Emergency Relief (ESSER) and *WILL NOT* affect other sources of reimbursement or funding your district may already be receiving.
