

### **Projects for Which Restoration Will Be Requested:**

- \$200,100 – Foundational professional development for teachers in the Science of Math, preparing educators to implement SB 2213.
- \$165,827 – Science of Reading professional development for teacher trainers to support statewide reading instruction.
- \$9,230 – Training for High-Impact Tutoring, aimed at accelerating student learning post-pandemic.
- \$176,494 – Regional Education Association (REA) work with schools to identify priority standards in core academic areas.
- \$184,822 – Intermediary support for the Personalized, Competency-Based Learning Network, aligned to North Dakota’s innovation in education efforts.
- \$541,903 – Access to Amira, an AI-powered reading tutor, provided to schools to improve literacy outcomes.
- \$255,518 – Covering student costs for dual enrollment courses aligned to North Dakota’s Choice Ready high school graduation pathway.
- \$45,000 – Completion of the groundwork required to implement SB 2264, aimed at improving chronically low-performing schools.
- \$150,000 – Continued training for teachers using the Native American Essential Understandings.
- \$123,039 – Funding for students’ enrollment fees in computer science or cybersecurity courses necessary to meet new North Dakota graduation requirements.
- \$25,897 – Support for afterschool tutoring programs to address unfinished learning.
