The SIS-A is a standardized assessment that measures the pattern and intensity of supports an adult (16 years and older) with intellectual and developmental disabilities requires to be successful in their community.

When will I have a SIS-A?

Assessments will be prioritized initially for individuals seeking services through the DD waiver who are new to waiver services.

- BDS staff will provide PCG with a prioritized list of individuals.
- PCG staff will schedule SIS-A assessments in collaboration with Area Agencies, service coordination entities, and individuals/families.
