177 tons of bottles, cans, paper and cardboard were recycled by the community this month.

This month's recycling efforts saved the following resources:

2,730 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 46,413,800 sheets of printing and copy paper!

417 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 532 people!

421,620 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 39 homes!

Avoided 453 Metric Tons (MTCO₂E) of GHG Emissions

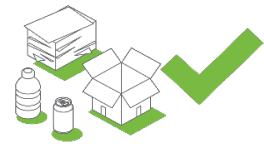
This GHG reduction is equivalent to removing annual emissions from 97 passenger vehicles!

1,122,996 Gallons of Water

Represents enough saved water to meet the daily fresh water needs of 14,973 people!
