198 tons of bottles, cans, paper and cardboard were recycled by the community this month.

This month's recycling efforts saved the following resources:

3,057 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 51,972,000 sheets of printing and copy paper!

466 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 596 people!

472,111 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 44 homes!

Avoided 507 Metric Tons (MTCO₂E) of GHG Emissions


This GHG reduction is equivalent to removing annual emissions from 109 passenger vehicles!

1,257,479 Gallons of Water

Represents enough saved water to meet the daily fresh water needs of 16,766 people!
