202 tons of bottles, cans, paper and cardboard were recycled by the community this month.

This month's recycling efforts saved the following resources:

3,122 Mature Trees

Represents enough saved timber resources to produce 53,072,200 sheets of printing and copy paper!

476 Cubic Yards of Landfill Airspace

Enough airspace to fulfill the annual municipal waste disposal needs for 608 people!

482,105 Kw-Hrs of Electricity

Enough power to fulfill the annual electricity needs of 45 homes!

Avoided 517 Metric Tons (MTCO₂E) of GHG Emissions

This GHG reduction is equivalent to removing annual emissions from 111 passenger vehicles!

1,284,098 Gallons of Water

Represents enough saved water to meet the daily fresh water needs of 17,121 people!
