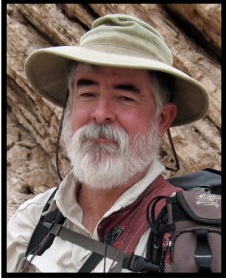


SUMMER HIGHLIGHT
