# POLICY DEVELOPMENT



- Passed a resolution that affirms the unique nature of Floyd Lamb Park at Tule Springs and protects it from commercial development
- Voted in favor of 2 ordinances that strengthen our animal welfare ecosystem
- Drafted an ordinance that addresses the impact of heat on homes
- Advocated for funding for the upcoming CSN NW Campus
- Engaging in regional conversations to:
  - Invest opioid settlement funds for rehabilitation & recovery services
  - Explore ways to address our housing crisis
- Supporting efforts to address law enforcement & mental health
