



A Day In the Life

Entering School

Colin puts on his mask as he prepares to enter the building. As he reports to his assigned entrance, based on his grade level, he stops and stands in line (6 ft. apart) to wait to have his temperature taken with a temporal thermometer. After the reading indicates that his temperature is below 100 degrees, he uses hand sanitizer and sanitizes his hands and then enters the building. As Colin walks straight to his classroom, he remembers to walk on the right side of the hallway as often as possible. He also knows that he is allowed to bring his backpack and coat to first bell, and that he will be allowed to visit his locker after first bell is over. Once he arrives at his classroom, Colin uses hand sanitizer, puts his belongings in his designated location, and then sits in his socially distanced seat.

Class Routines

In the classroom, Colin will be engaged in classroom activities and socially-distant discussions with his peers and teachers. Proper handwashing, hand sanitizing, and sanitizing of desks will occur throughout the day. Colin's teachers will spray his desk with a safe cleaning solution in between bells, and Colin knows he will be asked to wipe down his desk at the start of each bell with a paper towel. Colin will have school supplies for his use only. Social distancing and mask-wearing will be maintained during class time.

Hallway Routines

When Colin walks in the hallways he will maintain appropriate social distancing from others with his mask on. He will attempt to walk on the right side of the hallway when as much as possible. He is encouraged to take as many classroom materials with him as possible to limit trips to his locker.

Lunch

Colin and his classmates will all wash their hands or use hand sanitizer prior to lunch. He will then eat his lunch in a socially- distant seat in the cafeteria. This location will be sanitized prior to and after eating. Colin will have the opportunity to eat a lunch that he has brought from home or he can buy lunch at school. He will have the option to buy a hot or cold lunch in the cafeteria. After cleaning up his lunch, Colin will again wash or sanitize his hands and put on his face mask.

School Dismissal

When school is dismissed, Colin will maintain appropriate social distancing, walking on the right side of the hallway when able, with his mask on. Once Colin has left the building, he should go home. He should not stay on school property. If Colin needs help with an assignment, he may stay after school, but should immediately go to a teacher's classroom or report to an extracurricular, rather than congregating in the hallways.

At Home

Colin will log in to Schoology at home to locate his assignments and to prepare for the next day. On Schoology, Colin may find various learning activities or assignments listed that have been prepared for him by his teacher. This is especially important to check on blended A/B days. Colin and his family will set schedules and routines for the days for which Colin is not in school, and Colin will stick to these routines as much as possible. Colin will regularly check for missing assignments or upcoming due dates using Schoology, and Colin will be sure to reach out to his teachers when he has questions or is struggling. While Colin stays on top of things, his parents check on him and his Schoology account as needed to see if Colin needs any help. Colin will clean and charge his Chromebook before returning to school.
