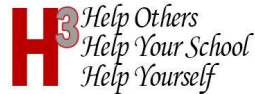

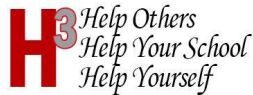
October 26th - November 6th

October 26th – November 6th

Even and Odd Days

- Rotate every other day, starting Monday Oct. 26th
- **Odd Days:** 10/26, 10/28, 11/3, and 11/5
 - Bells 1, 3, 5, 7
- **Even Days:** 10/27, 11/2, 11/4, and 11/6
 - Bells 2, 4, 6, X

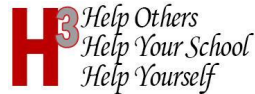

XBells

- Students will NOT have to report online for XBell periods
- Students should use XBell times to catch up on any missing work and prepare for any upcoming assignments
- Teachers will be using this time to communicate with students and families with any concerns
- Students MAY get extra help from teachers. This should be arranged ahead of time with the teacher.



Additional Notes/Considerations

Why Block Scheduling?

- More prolonged and focussed time within a period
- Fewer transitions
 - Less start/stop
 - Fewer tech glitches
- Opportunities for screen sharing and recorded lessons



Additional Notes/Considerations

What Will Instruction Look Like?

- Flexibility for teachers and students
- A typical day may have:
 - About 30 minutes of teacher-led or teacher-facilitated instruction
 - Combination of group work (breakout groups), individual Practice, and 2-way feedback
- Schoology will still be the best resource for students
