Attendance is required for your music grade. Make sure you check in with the music staff upon arrival.

Concert Attire:

Amity Choir and Band members should wear "dress clothes" with white on the top and black on the bottom, for a professional, formal appearance. This is standard for many school music groups. Students need to provide their own uniforms. All clothing should be school-appropriate and follow the Amity Elementary dress code.

Boys: Plain white dress shirt/collared shirt, with black pants, and nice shoes.

Girls: Plain white blouse/dressy top, with black knee-length skirt or black pants, and nice shoes.

Concert procedures/expectations:

- 1. Students are not to chew gum at the concert. Gum is unprofessional for musical performers and will not be tolerated; it can even damage musical instruments.
- 2. Use of cell phones is not permitted. They are to be put away and remain off during the entire concert. If at all possible, don't even bring one.
- 3. We ask that performers and audience members not use the restroom during the performance.
- 4. There will be NO TALKING while others are performing. Students are to behave in a professional manner at all times and be good audience members and listeners, showing respect. Any student who is causing problems will receive disciplinary action and will be docked points on their concert grade.
- 5. Students should only be in designated areas, NOT roaming the halls before/after the concert.
- 6. ALL SCHOOL RULES ARE STILL IN EFFECT.

Concert Attendance Policy

Students participating in Band/Choir are required to attend the concert as it is a grade for the class. Excused absences must be notified in writing/Schoology/via email PRIOR to the concert. The following are considered to be an excused absence:

- 1. Illness from school that day (excused absence)
- 2. Death in the Family
- 3. Religious Obligation
- 4. Family Emergency
