

In June 2025, Ohio Governor Mike DeWine and Ohio Department of Transportation (ODOT) Director Pamela Boratyn announced that the Transportation Improvement District (TID) Program would award \$8.9 million to support 26 transportation projects in 19 counties. The selected projects support the program's goals of job creation and retention, economic development, intergovernmental collaboration, and public-private investment. The Ohio Department of Transportation is the source of the above information. | Fulton County TID | SR 109 & CR H Road Improvements | This project in the Village of Delta is the full reconstruction of SR 109 at the intersection with CR H and from this intersection to the western entrance of the truck stop on CR H. These road improvements will provide easier and safer access to existing industries and open up 650 acres of developable land. Over \$602 million in capital investment is anticipated in the area. | 90 | 871 | CO | 2026 | \$500,000 |
| Sandusky County TID | Premier Drive Improvements | This project involves the full depth replacement, including drainage improvements, of the concrete pavement on the northern 900' of Premier Drive, in the City of Clyde. Multiple businesses in the industrial park have invested over \$94 million and additional acreage is available for development. | 65 | 183 | CO | 2026 | \$300,000 |
| Wood County TID | Bishop Road Realignment | This project entails the detailed design and right of way acquisition for the realignment of Bishop Road with Nims Road in the City of Bowling Green. | Medina County TID | Wooster Pike Improvements | This construction project in the City of Medina includes a southbound right turn lane on SR 3/Wooster Pike Rd. | Wayne County TID | Cleveland Road Roundabouts | This project entails the detailed design of roundabouts at the intersections of Cleveland Rd and Beall Ave and Cleveland Rd and Portage Rd in the City of Wooster. These improvements will alleviate congestion at the crossroads of the city's major north-south and east-west routes, directly supporting 235 businesses. | 0 | 2,039 | DD | 2026 | \$250,000 |
| Stark County TID | California Avenue Improvements | This project in the City of Louisville entails the detailed design of intersection improvements on California Ave at Crock Street NE, Williamsburg Way and SR 62 as well as a left turn lane at the intersection with Reno Dr. These improvements are needed for an \$8 million food manufacturing facility and retail store front. | 0 | 273 | DD | 2026 | \$231,000 |
| Stark County TID | Warmington Road SW Rehabilitation | This construction project in the City of Massillon is the complete pavement reconstruction and widening of Warmington Road from SR 21/US 62 to the western corporation limits. | Summit County TID | Akron-Canton Airport West Side Development Access Road | This construction project in the City of Green is the 900' extension of West Airport Drive. | Summit County TID | Seasons Road & Allen Road Intersection | This project in the City of Stow includes the construction of a new traffic signal at the intersection of Seasons Road and Allen Road. | Trumbull County TID | CH 69 Niles Warren River Road Improvements | This project entails the detailed design of improvements of CH 69 at the intersections of Burton St and Deforest Rd including a cul-de-sac in Howland Township. These improvements are required for existing businesses to continue freight logistic operations as well as a new company's investment of \$680 million. | 0 | 764 | DD | 2026 | \$121,250 |
| Trumbull County TID | Mines Road & SR 46 Intersection | This project will construct a left turn lane and traffic signal on Mines Rd at the intersection with SR 46 in Howland Township. | Franklin County TID | Rohr Rd Corridor Improvements | This project in Hamilton Township consists of widening Rohr Rd between Lockbourne Rd and Alum Creek Dr. The project will address, in various respects, vital capacity, safety and congestion issues, benefiting the traveling public and residents of the area and the region, as well as freight and logistics movements, and significantly facilitate and provide for economic expansion and development in and around the project area. | 325 | 0 | CO | 2026 | \$500,000 |
| Mercer County TID | Philothea Road Widening | This project entails the right-of-way acquisition of Philothea Rd in Butler Township that will benefit multiple agricultural businesses along the east-west corridor. | Montgomery County TID | North County Line Road Improvements | This project in the City of Union is the full-depth reconstruction and widening of 2,100' of North County Line Rd west of the Peters Pike/Lightner Road intersection. It will modernize a narrow road to efficiently move trucks and employees to an industrial park near the Dayton International Airport. This project will support over \$500 million in private sector capital investment. | 250 | 0 | CO | 2026 | \$500,000 |
| Montgomery County TID | West Carrollton River District Roadway Improvements | This project includes improvements to the Manchester Rd and Marina Dr intersection including a traffic signal, pavement markings, and storm sewer. Project also includes extending a mixed-use path along Marina Drive in the City of West Carrollton. These improvements will help the redevelopment of the formerly vacant River District site. | Butler County TID | I-75 & Millikin Interchange | This project in Liberty Township includes the right-of-way acquisition for the new diverging diamond interchange at I- 75 and Millikin Rd and the roundabouts at Cincinnati Dayton Rd and Butler Warren Rd. | Clermont County TID | Bach-Buxton Roundabouts | This project in Union Township includes the right-of-way acquisition for two roundabouts on Bach Buxton Rd. The project will create effective access management to developing properties as well as improvements to worker mobility. | Clermont County TID | Half Acre Road & Afton Drive Roundabout | This project entails the detailed design for a roundabout at the intersection of Half Acre Rd and Afton Dr in Williamsburg Township. | Clermont County TID | Mt. Carmel-Tobasco Road & Clough Pike Intersection Improvement | This project in Union Township includes the detailed design of intersection improvements at Mt. | Morgan County TID | Front Street Reconstruction | This construction project in the Village of Malta includes the improvements to lower Front Street/CR 2 south of the Veterans Memorial Bridge. These improvements will enhance access to a key commercial area and specifically the \$6 million expansion of a manufacturer. | 56 | 160 | CO | 2026 | \$500,000 |
| Noble County TID | Sarahsville Community Connectivity | This construction project includes improvements to Mill/Main/Cross St throughfare in the Village of Sarahsville. In coordination with a local bridge replacement project these improvements will remove barriers to local businesses. | Belmont County TID | SR 147 & Railroad Street Intersection Improvement | This construction project in the Village of Belmont includes realignment and radius improvements of the SR 147 and Railroad St intersection.
