The High School/College Prevention Internship Program is for Ohio Prevention Providers to receive reimbursement for hosting high school/college interns in prevention roles. .

The goal of the High School/College Prevention Internship Program is to provide prevention providers with the talent they need while also providing students with valuable work experience at an early age. Interns will be expected to perform job duties similar to what is expected of an entry-level employee in prevention roles that focus on prevention education & service delivery, communication, community organization, public policy & environmental change.

Prevention Providers will be provided a **\$5,120** stipend per intern. To qualify for the stipend, prevention providers complete one application per intern and must complete a brief report detailing the duties the intern completed.
