BEHAVIOR THREAT ASSESSMENT MANAGEMENT (BTAM) TRAINING

FBI Cleveland Division and the Ohio School Safety Center are hosting a **FREE** Behavior Threat Assessment Management (BTAM) training.

The Basic Threat Evaluation and Reporting Course (B-TERC) is a one-day training that teaches participants how to help assist in preventing acts of targeted violence, such as, but not limited to, terrorism, school shootings, or mass attacks in public spaces by identifying those threats or observable behaviors that may indicate the potential for violence.

The course also teaches participants how to apply the Behavioral Threat Assessment Management model in those prevention efforts. This B-TERC course is approved by the U.S. Department of Homeland Security: Office of Intelligence and Analysis.
