David is a recovery advocate who shares his personal journey to inspire hope and challenge the stigma surrounding addiction. He battled opioid addiction for over 20 years, starting with OxyContin and eventually progressing to heroin. This struggle led to numerous overdoses and the tragic loss of many friends and family members. Today, after seven years of being clean from opiates and heroin, David passionately speaks on behalf of those who can no longer speak for themselves.

He formerly served as the Director of Operations at New Hope Creations Residential Drug and Alcohol Treatment Center. Currently, he works for Perry County JFS Child and Adult Protective Services, where he continues to inspire and advocate for a brighter future for the individuals they serve.
