Workshop Description

The Federal Aviation Administration's Mike Monroney Aeronautical Center and the Human Resources Services Division are partnering to host two (2) workshops that are designed to provide classroom teachers with an introduction to various aspects of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (STEM) work and learning technologies in FAA.
