LARC fast facts

- ▶ IUDs and contraceptive implants are more than 99 percent effective. This makes them ideal options for preventing unintended pregnancies.
- ▶ IUDs and implants are reversible and safe for use in most women, regardless of age or previous pregnancies.
- ▶ IUDs and implants are low maintenance and discreet, making them popular birth control choices among women of childbearing age.
