



GET READY BEFORE YOU APPLY.

Your time is valuable. Before you apply, make sure you have the required documents ready.

YOUR VERIFICATION CHECKLIST:



Proof of who you are

Driver's license, birth certificate, U.S. passport, voter ID card, pay stub or school records.



Social Security numbers

For everyone in your home who wants benefits. The numbers alone are fine – you don't need the actual card.



Proof of what you earn **If you have a job.**

Pay stubs from the last 30 days, a note from your employer, or last year's tax return if self-employed.



Proof of other money **If this applies.**

Other benefit checks or award letters, child support or alimony records, or a court order showing the amount.



Citizenship documents **If not a U.S. citizen.**

A document that shows your lawful citizenship status.



Shelter and utility expenses

Receipts, bills or statements for housing costs and utilities.



Medical cost records **Optional. 60+ or disabled.**

Receipts or bills for medical care, prescriptions, Medicare premiums, or medical transportation. This can lower your countable costs.
