## Book & Lesson Study

- Who: <u>Core math teachers</u> or other teachers who <u>support students within a core math</u>

  <u>class or a math resource classroom</u> in <u>grades 6th-8th</u> who want to collaborate with and learn from other teachers.
- What: Participants will work through the book, The Math Pact. Achieving Instructional Coherence Within and Across Grades: Middle School (Bush, Karp, & Dougherty, 2020), along with additional reading materials as needed. A lesson study will accompany each chapter to allow teachers to practice and apply news skills. Participants should anticipate spending 1-2 hours per week on the course.
- When: We plan to select 20 educators and will notify participants by January 15, 2021. We will meet twice a month during the spring of 2021 (week of January 18th June) afterschool/early evening on Tuesdays or Wednesdays to meet the needs of participating general and special educators.
- Additional Info: Each participating teacher will <u>receive a copy of the book</u>, copies of any additional reading materials, lessons, and a \$500 stipend at the completion of the **Book and Lesson Study**.
