



Elementary Curriculum (Grades 4-6)

The majority of Jr. Hope Squad curriculum focuses on mental wellness, anti-bullying and resilience.

Secondary Curriculum (Grades 6-12)

The secondary Hope Squad curriculum focuses more heavily on identifying and referring struggling peers by focusing on resilience, connectedness, mental health and self-care.
