Keynote Session: Anything is Possible

Daniel Durany will be sharing his journey and how he navigated his time in school, employment, and relationships. He brings a unique perspective that 'Anything Is Possible'; as a person with Autism, he went from non-verbal to raising a family. His presentation will discuss his childhood trials and tribulations, transitioning experiences into adulthood, failures and successes in relationships and employment, and strategies he used to create the future he wanted for himself.



Daniel attended and graduated from Texas Christian University with his Bachelor of Science Degree in Communication Studies in 2006. He went on to complete his Master of Science Degree in Accounting in 2020.

In spring 2013, Daniel was appointed by the then Governor, Rick Perry, to serve the State of Texas on The Council on Autism and Pervasive Developmental Disorders. He currently volunteers with FEAT (Families for Effective Autism Treatment) that offers educational opportunities and conferences that has educated and provided support to over 25,000 parents and professionals. Through FEAT, Daniel was pivotal in pioneering a local adult Asperger's Support Group.

Daniel enjoys presenting at conferences and school districts. Bringing an enthusiastic perspective about autism, he will share his experiences and understanding of what life is like living with Asperger's. His presentation discusses his childhood struggles in school, transitioning experience from high school-to-college, and approaches to help others. Putting his skill of public speaking to use, Daniel continues to be an advocate in the field of Autism.

Daniel enjoys attending church services and spending time with his wife, Mandy, and son, Ben. In his spare time, he is a year-round sports official in volleyball, basketball, and softball officiating games on the college and high school level.
