Admission Process

To be eligible for admission to the Boot Camp sequence, an individual must:

- Have earned a bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Have a GPA of 3.0 or higher from previous degree program (may be admitted provisionally with a 2.75 GPA)

Oklahoma State University offers a 36-credit online master's degree in special education that focuses on working with children with mild/moderate disabilities in the special education and inclusive general education classrooms. Courses completed during the Boot Camp will be applied toward the master's degree. Boot Camp Curriculum

- SPED 5683: Models of Instruction in Inclusive Classrooms
- SPED 5743: Planning, Compliance and Current Practices
- SPED 5783: Assessing Students with Disabilities
- SPED 5883: Classroom and Behavior Management
