



## October 2024 EDPlan Updates

### **Review of Existing Data**

Service History panel: Currently, only the primary disability displays for students who are
receiving special education services and are undergoing a reevaluation. New functionality has
been added to display both primary and secondary disabilities documented in the previous
Eligibility Determination in this section of the RED.

#### Eligibility Process – New Early Childhood Transition Tile

To more efficiently track the transition of students from SoonerStart to Part B services, a new tile has been added to the Eligibility Process. The tile will allow districts to document within EDPlan the actions the LEA took in responding to the LEA notification and support their tracking of early childhood transition requirements. This Early Childhood Transition tile will display for all students, but will only be editable for students who are 2 or 3 years of age and are transitioning to your district from SoonerStart.

#### **Eligibility Process**



- The LEA Notification date will autopopulate based on the LEA Notification document created by SoonerStart.
- Indicate whether district staff attended the transition meeting, and the date of the meeting.
- If the district will not proceed with an initial evaluation, select the reason. No further information is required, you may create the Early Childhood Transition document.

If the district proceeds with the initial evaluation, continue as usual through the eligibility process.


IEP Create Draft/Final Page: if the IEP for a child transitioning from SoonerStart is not in place on or before the child's third birthday, an additional panel will display on the IEP Process Create Draft/Final page. This will allow for the documentation of the reason the IEP was not in place on or before the child's third birthday. The number of days beyond the third birthday is also displayed, this is calculated based on the child's date of birth and the IEP meeting date.
