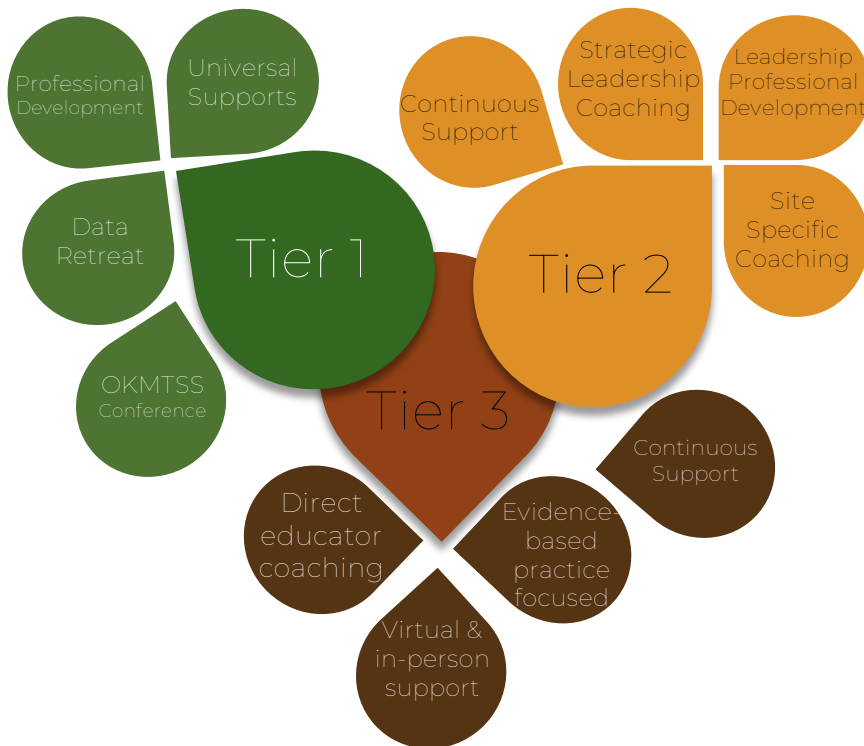


State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) 2025-2028 Interest Meetings

The State Systemic Improvement Plan (SSIP) is a comprehensive, ambitious, yet achievable multi-year plan for improving results for children with disabilities. Oklahoma has selected early literacy (K-3) as the state's target area. The Office of Special Education Services is working to improve early literacy at school sites by implementing a tiered intervention framework. The three tiers in the framework will provide different types of evidence-based interventions to site personnel who will implement those practices in their classes to benefit all students.
