Service Oklahoma is already celebrating big wins in 2024! Thanks to the incredible frontline staff, our new live wait map and the dedication of our entire team, Oklahomans have seen a dramatic decrease in their wait times at Service Oklahoma locations.

In January, our customers saw an average wait time of 14 minutes across the state. Together with increased staffing and more online service options, we've been able to decrease the average wait time by 86% compared to January 2023.
