Leadership Update



This month's Leadership Update comes from Tralynn Stevenson, Service Oklahoma's Director of Human Resources

Happy Fall, Service Oklahoma! October is one of my favorite months. It is when we start to get the

slightly crisp breezes and smells of autumn that make everything so warm and comforting. As many of you know, October is also the time for state employees to review their current benefits and decide if any changes are needed for the upcoming year.

As a state employee for 12 years, I've always appreciated the generous benefits allowance provided not only for myself but also for my family. Think about this: in 2025, your annual benefits allowance will start at \$9,042 for employee-only coverage, on top of your annual salary. If you choose to cover dependents, that allowance increases. The state is one of the few employers that extends additional benefits for dependents, not just employees. It's reassuring to know that the state understands every family has unique needs and provides multiple medical, dental and vision plan

options to help us choose what's best for our families.

The state also values work-life balance. Upon starting as a state employee, you receive 30 days of annual and sick leave, plus 11 paid holidays. And remember, your leave accrual increases every five years of service. Additionally, a new state law now offers up to six weeks of paid maternity leave for eligible employees, on top of your other leave benefits.

When it comes to planning for retirement, the state matches up to 7% of your contributions to the Pathfinder retirement savings plan, which now includes a Roth IRA option. This means we are investing in your future so that you can build a strong retirement for you and your family. Plus, Pathfinder gives employees the control to manage your money.

As you review your medical, dental and vision plan options during Option Period, remember that our Human Resources Division is here to assist with any

Open Enrollment for 2025

Open Enrollment for Plan Year 2025 begins on **Oct. 1** and will run through **Oct. 31. All employees must actively re-enroll in benefits during this period,** even if no changes are being made.

Plan details with comparisons and an <u>enrollment overview video</u>, are available on the <u>EGID website</u>. There are often plan changes that will impact overall cost, new or lost plans and certain benefits which do not rollover from one year to the next. For those reasons, employees are asked to actively re-enroll each option period, even if you are not making any changes.


