

Electronic Liens & Titles (ELT) Quick Reference Guide Licensed Operators



OVERVIEW

As of July 1, titles issued by Service Oklahoma will be issued in an electronic format with exceptions listed below. Titles issued to dealers will continue to default to paper issuance. Please note that there are no changes to the existing fee structure for licensed operators as a result of electronic titling.

SYSTEM CHANGES

- Consumer title transactions will result in the issuance of electronic titles
- Print Request Form enables paper title issuance for exceptions
- Duplicate fees are avoided if paper title is requested upfront
- Titles issued to dealers will continue to default to paper

PAPER TITLE EXCEPTIONS

Paper titles may be requested when

1. Vehicle is being moved out of state or jurisdiction
2. Vehicle is being sold out of state or jurisdiction
3. Vehicle is sold at auction
4. Vehicle is under floorplan lending
5. Vehicle is leased within six months of payoff
6. Vehicle is titled in dealer's name (issuance defaults to paper for dealers)

HOW TO REQUEST A PAPER TITLE

- Submit Print Request Form during or after transaction
- Standard statutory fees apply

DO DEALERS NEED TO SUBMIT THE FORM?

- Not for dealer title only; the system defaults to paper
- Yes for other exceptions

SUPPORT FOR DEALERS & LIENHOLDERS

- Process electronic lien filings
- Handle slip-in title requests
- Upload VIN inspection forms as needed

DUPLICATE & CORRECTION REQUESTS

- All post-July 1 duplicates will be issued electronically
- Print request titles will be processed as duplicate title requests
- Correction process remains the same; contact mvcorrections@service.ok.gov with questions

CUSTOMER PROCESS SUMMARY

- Customers will continue visiting their local licensed operator to register vehicles within two months of purchase.
- Electronic titles can be confirmed in a customer's OkCARS account.
- No paper title will be issued unless exception applies.
- No action needed for existing paper titles unless transacting.
