Subject: New Rules Effective June 28, 2016

The Oregon Medical Marijuana Program (OMMP) has permanently adopted and amended administrative rules that are effective June 28, 2016. These rules may be found on the OMMP website at: www.healthoregon.org/ommp

New rules regarding labeling, concentration limits, and testing, and changes to division 8 rules implementing legislation passed during the 2016 session are now in place. Highlights of some of the rule changes include:

- A new application process for dispensary and processor applications.
 - The five day deadline to submit additional required documentation has been extended to 30 days for new applications. All required documentation must be received within 30 calendar days of the date the applicant receives notice that their application has been received. OAR 333-008-1020 and 333-008-1620.
 - The renewal process requires submission of additional documentation. OAR 333-008-1070 and 333-008-1690
- Requirements for processing sites seeking an extract endorsement have been modified to no longer require a spark proof room, along with other changes. For a full text of changes, please review OAR 333-008-1800.
- Concentration limits for retail and medical marijuana products.
 - All marijuana products must comply with the limits set in rule by October 1, 2016.
 - Concentration limits found in Table 1 apply to retail marijuana products made by OLCC licensed processors and sold by OLCC licensed retail shops.
 - Medical marijuana dispensaries participating in early retail sales must follow rules outlined in OAR 333-008-1500 regarding which products may be sold to retail customers. The definition of a low-dose edible has not changed. Retail

customers may only purchase one low-dose edible with a concentration of no more than 15 milligram of THC in a unit from a medical marijuana dispensary.

- Pre-approval for labeling and child resistant packaging must be received before October 1, 2016, in order to meet the compliance deadline in OAR 333-008-1200(8) and 333-008-1740(10).
 - Medical marijuana registered processors, dispensaries, patients or growers who are packaging and/or labeling marijuana and marijuana product for ultimate sale to the consumer must receive approval from the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC) for their packaging and labeling.
 - The approval process opens August 1, 2016.
