

Conditions for US 395 Freight Travel with 53' Trailers

General conditions for a blanket single trip permit:

- Up to 5-day permit duration (permits valid Mon-Fri only)
- Permit 20 trips per week total for all carriers

Dimensions:

- 53' trailer

Restricted Routes:

- US 395 (Pilot Rock to Mt. Vernon)

Pilot Requirements (except as specified below):

- None

Hours of travel:

Daylight hours Monday – Friday, Except:

- Trailer equipped with enhanced middle and rear marker lighting. This will require district approval for each new hauler.

Special Approvals/Conditions

Exercise extreme caution between mile posts 50.5 and 65.0 due to sharp curves, narrow roadway, minimal shoulders, limited sight distance, rock bluffs, possible rocks in road, other trucks, RVs, and Snow Plow traffic.

- No traveling when road surfaces are hazardous due to ice, snow, or frost.
- No traveling during a weather event producing any amount of snow accumulation or low visibility, on any day with a national weather service forecast of snow accumulation or low visibility, or any day determined by the driver to be hazardous conditions for operating.
- It is the driver's responsibility and duty to determine the road conditions and safety of the route prior to embarking on a trip.
- Prior to traveling drivers may check ODOT trip www.tripcheck.com check for current camera view at Battle Mountain, Battle Mountain automated weather station, road and weather updates, or use other tools deemed helpful.
- Drivers should be prepared to delay their trips or pull over due to unsafe weather or driving conditions.
- Reduce speed.
- Apply special attention to staying in your lane (do not cross the centerline).
- Use commercial radios to communicate with other drivers via CB radio channel 4.
- Make an effort to communicate with ODOT snow plow trucks via CB radio channel 4 to communicate location and reduce narrow passing conflicts.
- Use turnouts to allow traffic to pass when needed.
- Review hazard map (attached) and use extreme caution at the following curve locations between MP 50.5 and 65.0:
 - MP 52.0 – 52.1 Sharp Curves, Narrow Roadway
 - MP 53.0 – 53.3 Sharp Curves, Narrow Roadway
 - MP 57.3 Sharp Curve, Narrow Roadway
 - MP 58.8 Sharp Curve, Narrow Roadway
 - MP 64.4 Curve Correction
