



NOTICE OF ROAD WORK

OR HWY. 244 CHIP SEAL

(Ukiah-Hilgard Hwy.)

Beginning August 8 the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will be chip sealing the Ukiah-Hilgard Highway (OR 244) in Union and Umatilla counties between the junction of U.S. Hwy. 395 at mile post zero and the junction of Interstate 84 at mile post 47 (Hilgard State Park). The project is expected to take three weeks to complete and will include resurfacing the pavement through downtown Ukiah.



PARKING RESTRICTIONS: To accommodate chip seal activities in Ukiah, vehicles will not be allowed to park along Main Street (OR 244) in the downtown area for 1-2 days during these operations. The No Parking restrictions are anticipated around August 22. No parking reminders will be posted in the area.

TRAVEL IMPACTS: Expect up to 20-minute delays, reduced speeds, loose rock on the roadway, flaggers, and pilot cars directing single lane traffic through the work zones. Minor delays during nighttime/early morning hours for road sweeping. Please slow down and watch for construction activities in the area and plan extra travel time during this highway preservation project.

REQUEST TO RANCHERS: To prevent chip rock adhesion problems due to animal waste on the roadway, ODOT is asking ranchers to keep all cattle and other livestock off the highway August 2 through August 28. Animals can be driven on appropriate open range highway sections after the chip seal has been applied.
