NOTICE OF ROAD WORK



U.S. HWY. 95 PAVING PROJECT

(Idaho-Oregon-Nevada Hwy.)

Beginning August 10 contractors for the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will be paving a section of the Idaho-Oregon-Nevada Highway (U.S. 95) west of Jordan Valley in Malheur County. The paving work will be constructed between the west end of Jordan Valley (west of the Rock House where sidewalk ends) at mile post 20.71 to mile post 25.62. An additional short half-mile section will also receive pavement resurfacing between mile post 57.7 and 58.05 (about eight miles east of Burns Junction).

TRAVEL IMPACTS: Expect up to 20-minute delays, reduced speeds, flaggers, and pilot cars directing single lane traffic through the work zones. Paving work is expected to be constructed during nighttime, with other operations performed during the day. Please slow down and watch for construction activities in the area and plan extra travel time during this highway preservation project. All travelers are reminded to wait for and follow pilot cars through the work zone and to not stop or pull off to the side of the roadway while in the pilot car line.

REQUEST TO RANCHERS: To prevent pavement adhesion problems due to animal waste on the roadway, ODOT is asking ranchers to keep all cattle and other livestock out of the work zones until the project is completed. Animals can be driven on appropriate open range highway sections after the striping has been applied.
