Emergency bridge work on Victory Boulevard begins

What

Oregon Department of Transportation crews will replace rotting wooden bridge supports with steel supports on a bridge carrying Interstate Avenue.

The bridge is located where North Interstate Avenue (OR 99W) crosses over North Victory Boulevard, just west of Interstate 5 in North Portland.

Schedule


Work will begin in March and is scheduled to take about two months to complete. Work could begin as early as Monday, March 12.

Signs will be placed in advance of work. For up-to-date traffic impacts, use <u>Tripcheck.com</u>.

Impacts

Travelers should expect a single lane closures on Victory Boulevard in both directions 24/7 all days of during the repair work.

During the second half of construction, the sidewalk on the south side of Victory Boulevard will be closed. The sidewalk on the north side will remain open. Pedestrians, including those with disabilities, will be accommodated.



The wooden supports on the bridge that carries Interstate Avenue over North Victory Boulevard are rotting. This project will replace the wooden supports with new steel supports.
