What is distracted driving?

Distraction occurs when a driver voluntarily diverts attention to something not related to driving that uses the driver's eyes, ears, or hands.

Auditory

- **Visual:** looking at something other than the road
- **Auditory:** hearing something not related to driving
- **Manual:** manipulating something other than the wheel
- **Cognitive:** thinking about something other than driving

Most distractions involve more than one of these types, with both a sensory -- eyes, ears, or touch -- and a mental component.

Distracted driving in Oregon

Distracted driving is a dangerous behavior for drivers, passengers, and non-occupants alike. Distraction is a specific type of inattention that occurs when drivers divert their attention from the driving task to focus on some other activity instead.

- From 2012-2016 There were 10,814 crashes resulting in 70 fatalities and 16,503 injuries caused by crashes involving a **distracted driver** in Oregon (**all ages**).
- 2012-2016 There were 1,040 crashes involving a driver (**all ages**) reported to have been **using a cell phone** at the time of the crash: 19 fatalities and 4,497 people injured.
- 2012-2016 There were 100 crashes involving a driver age **16-18** reported to have been **using a cell phone** at the time of the crash: 0 fatalities and 138 people injured.
- 2012-2016 There were 87,839 **convictions** for this offense.
- 2012-2016 There were 30 crashes involving, but not limited to a **Pedestrian**, using a cell phone: 4 fatalities and 26 injuries.
- 2012-2016 There were 12 crashes involving, but not limited to a **Pedalcyclist**, using a cell phone: 0 fatalities and 12 people injured.
- 2012-2016 There were 188 **work zone distracted driving** crashes: 2 fatalities and 315 people injured.
