



NOTICE OF ROAD WORK

OR HWY. 201-S CHIP SEAL (Succer Creek Hwy.)

Beginning June 25 the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) will be chip sealing a portion of OR Highway 201-S in Malheur County from just north of the town of Adrian at mile post 11.7 and the Oregon/Idaho border at mile point 22.2. The project will begin at the state line on June 25 and work north towards Adrian, ending near mile point 16.7. On June 26, crews will begin at mile post 11.7 and work south, back to MP 16.7.



PARKING RESTRICTIONS: To accommodate chip seal activities in Adrian, vehicles will not be allowed to park along Main Street (OR 201) in the downtown area on June 26. Please park vehicles along side streets and not along the highway. No parking reminders will be posted in the area.

TRAVEL IMPACTS: Expect up to 20-minute delays, reduced speeds, loose rock on the roadway, flaggers, and pilot cars directing single lane traffic through the work zones. Also watch for road sweeping operations that will result in minor delays during nighttime/early morning hours for one or two days following the chip seal application. Please slow down and watch for construction activities in the area and plan extra travel time during this highway preservation project. Loose rock on the roadway may be present for several days following the project. Please drive with extra caution and remember traffic fines are double the amount in all work zones.

REQUEST TO RANCH AND FARM OWNERS: ODOT is asking highway users to keep farm equipment off the highway June 25 – 26. To prevent chip rock adhesion problems due to animal waste on the roadway, ranchers are requested to keep cattle and other livestock off the highway June 16 – 27. Animals can be driven on appropriate open range highway sections after the chip seal has been applied.



NOTE: Chip seal work is weather dependent. All dates are subject to change, depending on weather condition.
